Please note that students will need to arrange their own transport to and from the opening and closing ceremony components and also their journey leg. Stanley River EEC will assist in setting up communication lines between participating students and parents in order to enable carpooling.

Further Information for Applicants

Cost

• There is no cost to apply, successful applicants will be required to pay a participation cost of \$350 per student

Section Process

- The application window is now open and will close on Friday 1st of November 2024.
- You will receive email confirmation that your application has been received and you may be contacted for further information.
- In line with Department of Education principals of Co design, all applications will be considered by the Bunya to The Bay Elders group. This group is made up of representatives from the Traditional Owner groups of the Countries that are travelled on the Bunya to the Bay journey.
- Applicants and schools will be notified of selection progress by 22nd November 2024

Selection Criteria:

- Eligible applicants will be enrolled in a high school in grades 10, 11 or 12 in the 2025 school year.
- Applications will be assessed on the **content and intention of the response**, not on the method of response.
- Preference will be given to students who are able to show
 - o An interest in a career path that connect to the Bunya to the Bay experience.
 - o Who are inspired by being in the outdoors.
 - o A connection to country.
 - o A passion for environmental sustainability.
- Preference may be given to students in years 11 or 12 who will be ineligible to apply for the 2027 journey.
- Bunya to the Bay staff may get in contact with applicants, guardians and/or supporting teachers for clarification
 of responses.

Selection Outcome

Unfortunately, there are limited places in this project and not all applicants are able to be included in the journey as River Ambassadors.

- Applicants and schools will be notified of selection progress by 22nd November 2024
- Due to processing time of applications the Bunya to the Bay organising team may require additional time to properly consider all applications. All applicants will be informed of any timeline changes.
- Applicants will be informed of three possible outcomes:
 - 1. That they have been selected as a River Ambassador
 - 2. That they have been selected as a back-up River Ambassador (to participate if a selected ambassador is no longer available)
 - 3. That they have not been selected as a River Ambassador for the upcoming journey
